



Dental Desensitization



Some persons may have **significant anxiety about dental visits** resulting in difficult in-office experiences or avoidance of important routine dental services altogether. **Dental Desensitization can help and is a covered service by Partners Health Plan.**



What is Dental Desensitization?

Desensitization involves a series of short office visits, where no treatment is provided, introducing new things at each visit, ending on a positive note.

Although this is a time consuming process, **it allows the person to become more comfortable with the dental office environment**, become familiar with office staff, and better understand what they can expect on the day of their service.

There is **no cost to our members** when participating in desensitization visits.
